Check MyUW for holds or missing grades.
Run your degree audit (DARS) to make sure you will satisfy all degree requirements as outlined for your major: • Applied Mathematics (AMATH) • AMATH Data Science (AMATH-DS) • Computational Finance & Risk Management (CFRM) • CFRM Data Science (CFRM-DS)
International students should review the <u>Final Year Checklist</u> provided by ISS.
Forward your <u>UW email address</u> and preserve your UW work before graduation.
Check out job search resources from the Career & Internship Center.
About one month after graduation, the <u>Office of the University Registrar</u> will send you an email with a link so that you may update your diploma name and mailing address. Your diploma name does not need to match your UW record name. <u>Diplomas</u> are mailed 3-4 months following graduation. For degree verification purposes, you may request an <u>official transcript</u> or purchase a <u>Certified Electronic Diploma</u> .
